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## How to Pronounce the I in Spanish

In this session we will take a look at the third vowel in Spanish, the letter “i”, which is pronounced as a short double “ee” in English.

- La iguana - Iguana
- El iglú - Igloo
- Igual - Equal
- Imán - Magnet
- Intelectual - Intellectual
- Inteligente - Intelligent
- Internacional - International
- Investigar - To research
- La isla - Island
- Iglesia - Church
- Ídolo - Idol
- Izquierda - Left
- Iván - Ivan
- Iniciar - To begin
- India - India
- Islandia - Iceland
- Italia - Italy
- Imitar - to imitate
- Imaginar - To imagine
- Información - Information

A fun way to remember how to pronounce the vowel I in Spanish, is to think of this unexpected situation:

“Three Iguanas build an Igloo”

This unexpected mental image, will help you memorize the correct pronunciation of the vowel I in Spanish.

That will help you remember how to pronounce the letter i in Spanish. As a short double “e” in English.
