Tengo una reservación.
2. I booked a room for two nights.
Reservé una habitación por dos noches.
3. Do you have any rooms available?
¿Tiene habitaciones disponibles?
4. I would like a single room.
Quisiera una habitación individual.
5. I would like a double room.
Quisiera una habitación doble.
6. Is breakfast included?
¿Está incluido el desayuno?
7. What time is check-in?
¿A qué hora es el registro?
8. What time is check-out?
¿A qué hora es la salida?
9. Can I see the room first?
¿Puedo ver la habitación primero?
10. I'll take the room.
Me quedo con la habitación.



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11. I would like to pay now.
Quisiera pagar ahora.
 12. Can I pay with a credit card?
¿Puedo pagar con tarjeta de crédito?
 13. Where is the elevator?
¿Dónde está el elevador?
 14. Is there Wi-Fi in the room?
¿Hay internet inalámbrico en la habitación?
 15. What's the Wi-Fi password?
¿Cuál es la contraseña del internet inalámbrico?
 16. Can you help me with my luggage?
¿Puede ayudarme con mi equipaje?
 17. Where is the bathroom?
¿Dónde está el baño?
 18. The room is too hot.
La habitación está muy caliente.
 19. The room is too cold.
La habitación está muy fría.
 20. There is no hot water.
No hay agua caliente.



21. The air conditioner doesn't work.
El aire acondicionado no funciona.

22. I need more towels.
Necesito más toallas.

23. Can I have another blanket?
¿Puedo tener otra cobija?

24. What time is breakfast?
¿A qué hora es el desayuno?

25. Thank you, everything is perfect.
Gracias, todo está perfecto.
