## How to pronounce O in Spanish

The letter O in Spanish is pronounced as a short “oh” just as if you added the letter H after the O.

Here are a few common examples that include the letter o in Spanish:

- ojo – eye – ojo
- ola – wave – ola
- oro – gold – oro
- ocho – eight – ocho
- oeste – west – oeste
- once – eleven – once
- olor – smell / odor – olor
- oración – sentence / prayer – oración
- ocasión – occasion – ocasión
- oscuro – dark – oscuro



- olvidar – to forget – olvidar
- opción – option – opción
- octubre – October – octubre
- oso – bear – oso
- orden – order – orden
- oficina – office – oficina
- origen – origin – origen
- objeto – object – objeto
- obtener – to obtain / to get – obtener
- oportunidad – opportunity – oportunidad
